Severe Weather Emergency Plan.

The Parish Council has signed up for the Devon County Council snow warden scheme, under this scheme we are supplied with 5 tons of salt which is stored in a secure location and it's distribution is strictly controlled.

This will not have any effect on the existing salt bins which will still be serviced by the county council.

We have also purchased a tow along salt spreader which will be used by a team of volunteers on pre-defined routes through the village in severe weather to attempt to give access to the main roads which are treated by the county council.

We have also purchased a number of snow shovels which have been placed in various locations, including the pub and the shop, these are for the use of whoever may need to use them.

Although the distribution of the salt is restricted, anyone that is in desperate need of salt or are in need of help should contact one of the two numbers listed below, but please remember that resources are limited and everyone helping is a volunteer.

If we should have bad weather anyone that is willing to help should again contact one of the numbers below, but please be warned that this could be at your own risk.
