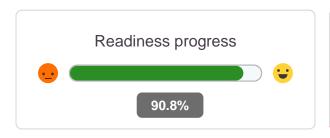

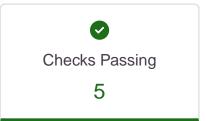

Contrast

Ensuring text and key elements have sufficient contrast for users with visual impairments.

× FAIL

Ensure text has sufficient contrast (AA)

WCAG 2.0 AA 1.4.3

PASS

Ensure links are distinguished by more than just color

WCAG 2.0 A 1.4.1

PASS

Ensure form controls contrast sufficiently with their surroundings WCAG 2.1 AA 1.4.11

Navigation

Issues that make it hard for users—especially those relying on assistive technology—to find and move through content.

FAIL

Ensure links can be used by screen readers

WCAG 2.0 A 4.1.2

WARNING

Ensure there are multiple ways to access a page WCAG 2.0 AA 2.4.5

WARNING

Ensure that navigation remains consistent

WCAG 2.0 AA 3.2.3

Writing

Matters of clear language and content structure so that the meaning is easy to understand.

WARNING

Check that headings and labels are descriptive

WCAG 2.0 AA 2.4.6

PASS

Use text to convey information where possible

WCAG 2.0 AA 1.4.5

PASS

Ensure content is not too difficult to understand

WCAG 2.0 AAA 3.1.5

Semantics

Proper markup, document structure, and labeling that help assistive technologies understand and convey the page content.

WARNING

Ensure HTML is in a meaningful sequence

Ensure components are identified consistently

Check that each page has an appropriate title

Timed Interactions

Ensuring that timed events, animations, and dynamic content give users enough control and do not force interactions.



WARNING

Ensure users can pause or hide animated content

Check pages for three flashes (Level A)

PASS

Avoid delayed meta refresh tags

▲ Interactive Elements

Ensuring that interactive components (beyond standard form controls) offer accessible alternatives.

MARNING

Ensure drag and drop movements have an accessible alternative

WARNING

Ensure help is presented consistently

WCAG 2.2 A 3.2.6

PASS

Ensure dialogs have labels

WCAG 2.0 A 1.3.1

Alternative Text

Images and visual elements need appropriate alternative text so screen reader users understand their purpose.

PASS

Specify alternative text for appropriate images

WCAG 2.0 A 1.1.1

PASS

Images with empty alternative text must not specify titles

WCAG 2.0 A 1.1.1

PASS

Specify alternative text for image buttons

WCAG 2.0 A 1.1.1

Audio & Video

Ensuring that audio and video content have captions, descriptions, or text alternatives as needed.

PASS

Ensure captions are provided for all live audio WCAG 2.0 AA 1.2.4

PASS

Ensure prerecorded audio has text alternative WCAG 2.0 A 1.2.1

PASS

Ensure prerecorded video has text alternative WCAG 2.0 A 1.2.1

Responsive Design

Ensuring the site works well on various screen sizes, including proper zooming, touch target sizes, and user control over presentation.

PASS

Ensure pages don't require zooming and 2D scrolling on small screens WCAG 2.1 AA 1.4.10

PASS

Ensure pinch-to-zoom is enabled

WCAG 2.0 AA 1.4.4

PASS

Ensure interactive components are far enough apart WCAG 2.2 AA 2.5.8

Forms

Ensuring that forms and related interactions are clear, correctly labeled, and easy to complete.

PASS

Ensure labels or instructions are provided when content requires user input WCAG 2.0 A 3.3.2

PASS

Identify the purpose of fields programmatically WCAG 2.1 AA 1.3.5

PASS

Add a submit button to all forms WCAG 2.0 A 3.2.2

Keyboard & Focus

Ensuring that interactive controls can be reached via keyboard and that focus is clearly visible.

PASS

Ensure custom tabbing order makes sense WCAG 2.0 A 2.4.3

PASS

Ensure applet or plugin provides ability to move the focus away from itself WCAG 2.0 A 2.1.2

PASS

Ensure functionality is available to keyboard users WCAG 2.0 A 2.1.1
